PROTECTING THE GALÁPAGOS, TODAY AND TOMORROW



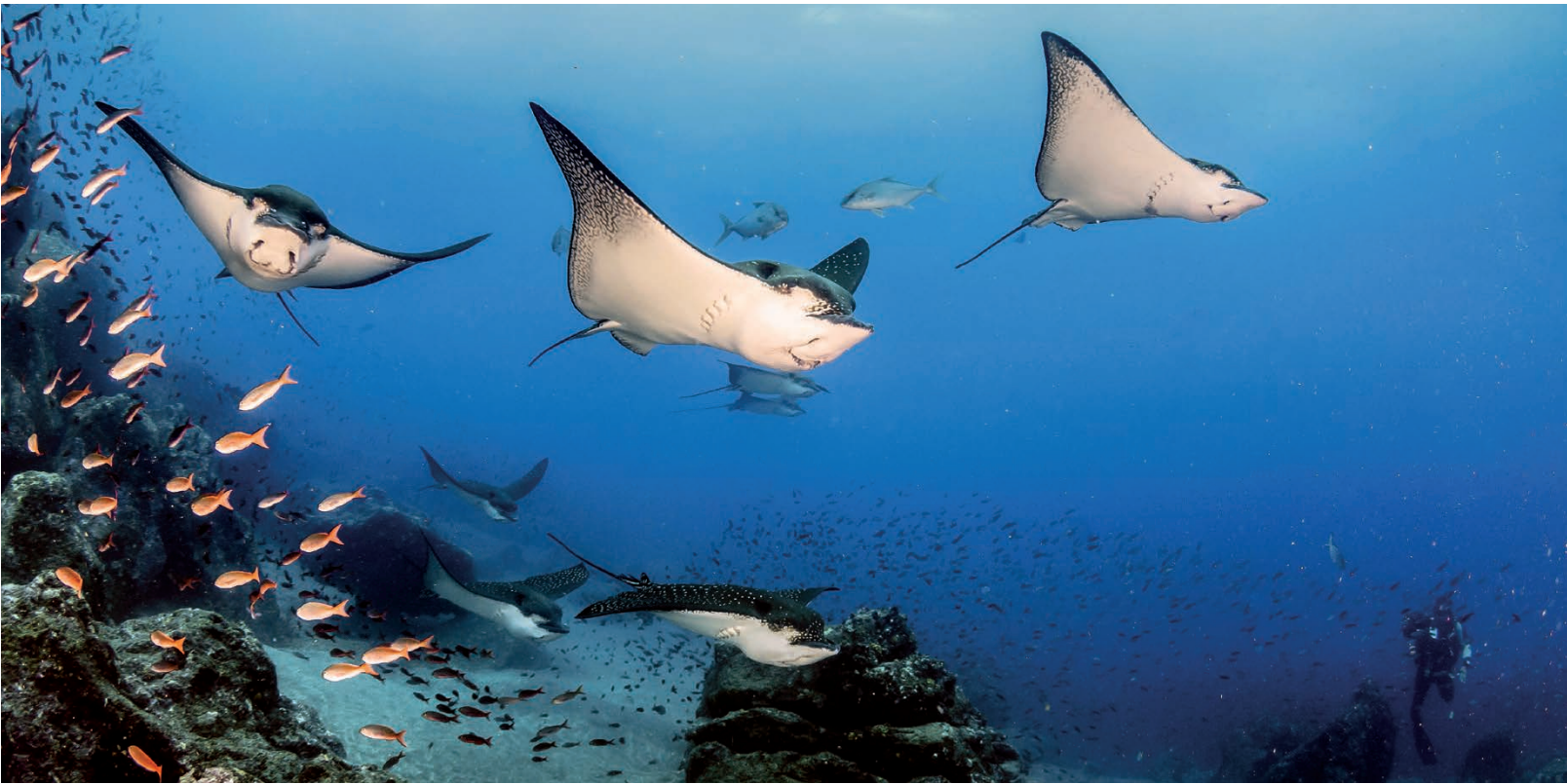

With state-of-the-art technology and solutions adopted explicitly for sailing here, the ship's footprint is minimal, and includes a dynamic positioning system that keeps her stationary without needing an anchor, protecting the delicate seabed and underwater flora and fauna. And thanks to a new hull design and advanced propulsion system, *Silver Origin* will meet or exceed the highest standards of energy efficiency, while all suites feature a fresh water purification system that significantly reduces plastic bottle usage.

As education is often cited as the best way to encourage proper conservation, we created the Silversea Fund for the Galápagos. Dedicated to safeguarding the archipelago through innovative educational projects, the fund is a big part of our commitment to keep the islands as pristine as possible, for generations to come.
